The project took about 120 hours to complete and the client was very satisfied with the end product. I revamped their workflow using Gulp and Webpack and ensured all strings, even the Gutenberg ones, were translatable as that was very important to them. I was also tasked to ensure the plugin worked well with 5.0, so there were a bit of refactoring styles to match to the new editor.
